
Arrested for her role in planning the assassination of the well-known Israeli agent and collaborator, Husayn Abdel Nabi, Baidoun was at one point detained with Soha Bechara, a fellow militant whose similar operation is better known. Her activism rooted in her Islamic faith, Baidoun shatters the notion that Muslim women did not play an active role in the armed resistance.

**NAWAL BAIDOUN** is a lifelong militant and activist from Bint Jbeil, South Lebanon. Before the occupation she graduated from law school; she subsequently worked as a teacher; and today is the Principal of the High School in Bint Jbeil.

**MICHELLE HARTMAN** is Professor of Arabic Literature and Director of the Institute of Islamic Studies, McGill University. She has translated numerous works by Arab women writers.

CALINE NASRALLAH is a Master's student at McGill University, where her research focuses on language as a feminist tool.


HAMMOUR ZIADA is an award-winning Sudanese writer and journalist. His previous novel The Longing of the Derwish won the 2014 Naguib Mahfouz Medal for Literature and was shortlisted for the International Prize for Arabic Fiction. The publication of a short story tackling child abuse in Sudan had previously exposed him to violent criticism from conservative and Islamist currents in Sudan. In 2009, his home in Khartoum was set to fire and he has been living in Cairo ever since.






